# SEPTEMBER 11, 2001

On September 11, 2001, thousands of Americans gathered at the World Trade Center in New York City, and Washington, D.C., in a coordinated effort to support the victims and their families. The attacks on the World Trade Center and the Pentagon in Arlington, Virginia, leaving about 3,000 people dead, thousands injured, and over 6,000 people missing. When the passengers attempted to breach the cockpit, the hijacker pilot had changed course toward the national capital, instead the plane was hit in Somerset County, Pennsylvania, near the town of Shanksville.

Nearly 1,000 people were killed or injured by the crash, the largest loss of life resulting from a single aircraft in American history, and the greatest single loss of life of the world's population, an estimate is how almost the entire world's population of 6 billion, with and around the world.





# IN MEMORIAM

This exhibition honors the 2,977 individuals killed as a result of the terrorist acts of September 11, 2001 at this site as well as at the Pentagon and in Somerset County, Pennsylvania, and the six individuals killed in the terrorist bombing of the World Trade Center on February 26, 1993.

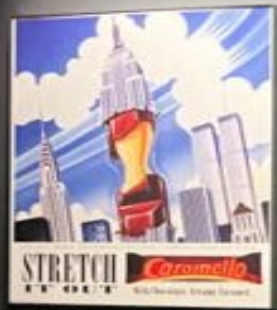

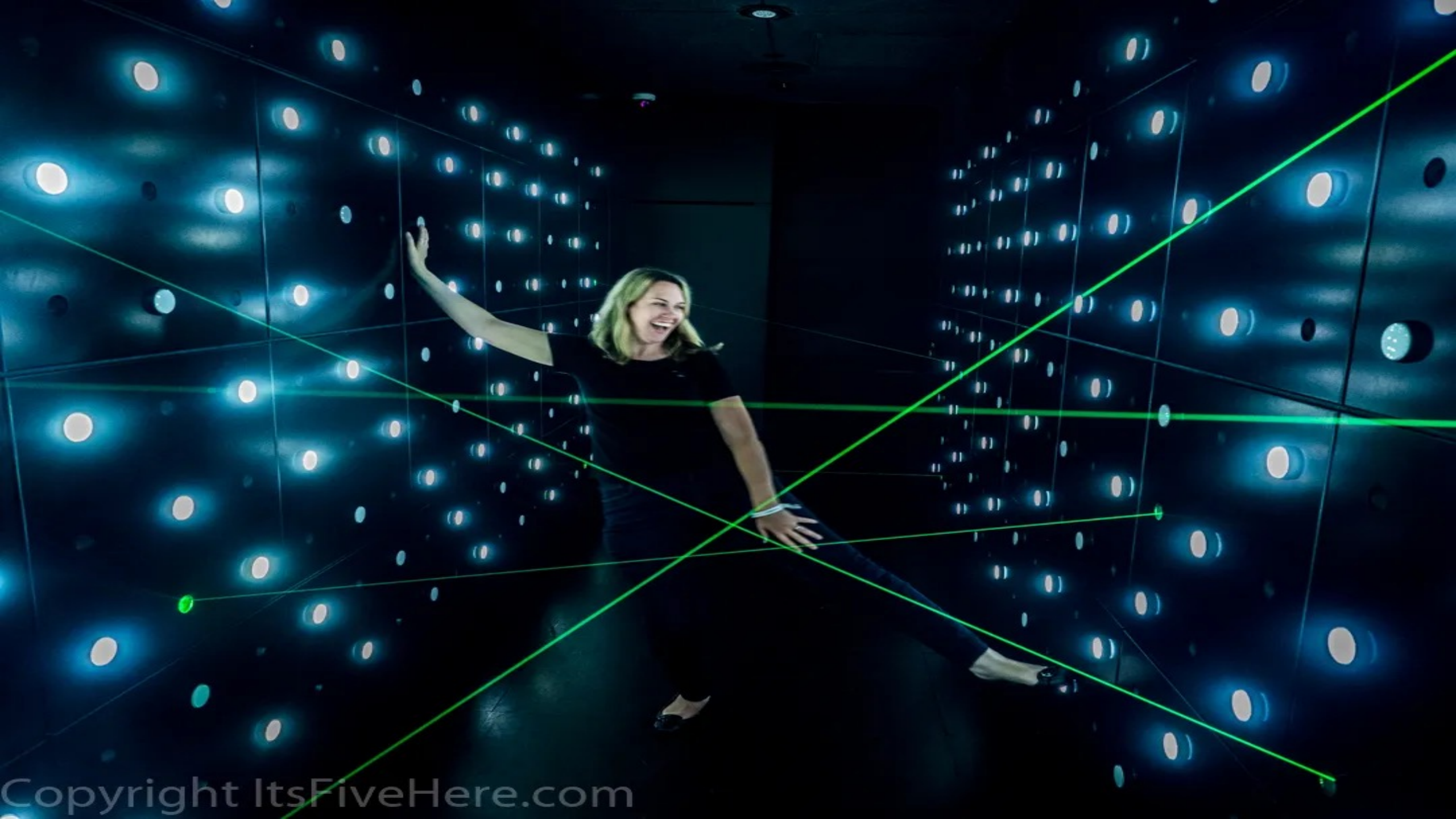
